If I need to go to the toilet I will look for the signs by Box Office or by the Circle Bar on Level 1. The accessible toilet is by Box Office.




This is the Main House Auditorium.

When everyone is ready the actors will come out onto the stage and the show will start.

In a relaxed performance I do not have to worry about making noise or moving around.



During the play I might feel happy or sad. It is ok to laugh or feel sad if I want to.

If I would like to take some time out during the show or go to the toilet the doors will be open so I may leave at any time and sit in the café until I am ready to go back in.

At the end of the show everyone will clap their hands if they have enjoyed it.

When the clapping has ended the lights will get brighter and I can leave the theatre.
